GENERAL QUESTIONS

1. Is SSN and SNU Chennai same?

Ans:

SSN and SNU Chennai are completely different entities.

Sri Sivasubramaniya Nadar (SSN) College of Engineering is an autonomous institution affiliated to Anna University, Chennai with the campus at Kalavakkam. SSN College of Engineering is run by the SSN Trust. The counselling code of SSN College of Engineering in TNEA - Anna University's single window counselling is 1315.

SNU (Shiv Nadar University) Chennai is a state-private university legislated by the Govt. of Tamilnadu. The online application form and admission processes are completely different for both. The online application form and admission process of SNU is not valid for admission to SSN College of Engineering and vice versa.

2. What is the procedure for the admission process in SSN College of Engineering?

Ans:

SSN admits students through 2 modes:

- 1. Admission to Government quota of SSN College of Engineering is through single window system of Anna University called TNEA.
- 2. Management quota admission at SSN is completely MERIT-based. It starts with filling out the online data at https://apply.ssn.edu.in/ssn-college-of-engineering-form

Students are called for counselling as per merit. Further communication will be sent to the student's registered email address.

3. What is the fee structure for the Management Quota admissions? How much more is it from Government Quota?

Ans:

Students at SSN College of Engineering are charged fees prescribed by the Fee Fixation Committee guidelines. The difference between Management and Government quota fees is Rs.70,000 (approx.) annually. A detailed break-up of the fees will be sent to the registered email address at the time of admission.

4. Where can I get scholarship details?

5. What is the procedure to shift to SSN from Anna University Affiliated college in the 2^{nd} year or 3^{rd} year?

All seats at SSN College of Engineering are filled strictly based on Merit. Lapsed seats (if any) will be filled based on availability.
