6. What are the different scholarships available for M.E./ M.Tech. program students?

1) Merit Scholarship:

For GATE candidates -

- a) Scholarship amount of INR 1,00,000 per annum for a percentile of 90 and above
- b) Scholarship amount of INR 75,000 per annum for a percentile of 80 to 89

2) Walk-in Walk-out scholarship:

100% scholarship for Top 10 Anna University rank holders in B.E./B.Tech. program

3) Ranks holder Scholarship:

50% scholarships for the first rank holders of private university

4) Merit cum Means Scholarship:

50% Tuition fee waiver for students with a family income under Rs. 3 lakhs per annum.
