Career Development Workshop by Alumni Association

Career Development Programme from Mechanical Department

As part of the monthly alumni activities, an interaction session for December 2024 was conducted with **Ms. Shoba Elumalai**, an alumna from the 2022 batch of B.E. Mechanical Engineering. She provided valuable insights into selecting project topics, IFSPs, and other academic activities based on individual areas of interest. Additionally, she offered practical advice on interview preparation, resume development, and other career-oriented skills.

The undergraduate students asked a variety of insightful questions during the session, including:

- What is the impact of internships, whether paid or unpaid, on placements and higher studies?
- Is the role in a company chosen by us or assigned to us?
- What steps should we take to change roles when transitioning from one company to another?
- What are the implications of frequently switching companies?
- What level of patent achievement is expected from a college student?
- Can we refine and narrow down our area of interest during the IFSP or final-year project stages?



Alumni Talk 1: Dr. Subalalitha on "Fine-Tuning Large Language Models: A Hands-On Approach"



Alumni Talk 2: Dr. Sowmya Sundram on "Introduction to Multimodal LLMs: CLIP, DALL-E, Flamingo"



Shyamal Rao Palli, an alum of SSN College of Engineering (2002–2006), has always embraced challenges. His journey began with his father challenging him to secure admission to Sainik School Amaravathinagar, where he developed a strong foundation in discipline and perseverance. Despite setbacks in his medical aspirations, Shyamal chose engineering and joined SSN College, where he excelled both academically and in extracurricular activities.

Hailing from a middle-class family, he took a loan for his studies and received a **merit scholarship** in his second semester. He

committed to giving back by volunteering for various roles like class representative and symposium in-charge. As President of the Association of Information Technologists (2005), he led his team to double the symposium's sponsorship and participation, raising 3 lakh INR and attracting 2,000 participants. He also **played a key role in organizing SSN's first inter-college cultural fest, Instincts 1.0, which saw 10,000 students attend**.

Shyamal's leadership extended beyond the campus. He contributed to the success of Tribute 1.0, the SSN alumni meet in 2010, and later served as President of the USA Chapter of the SSN Alumni Association. Under his leadership, alumni raised funds for scholarships benefiting rural students. In 2024, 200 alumni raised 20 lakh INR to support 50 students.

Currently, Shyamal is an Executive Director at Morgan Stanley, leading a global department in Operations Technology. With a career spanning 16 years, he specializes in digital transformation and legacy modernization. He holds a Master's degree in Computer Science from Johns Hopkins University.

Living in the US with his wife and children, Shyamal is passionate about learning and mentoring, particularly in technology and finance.
