

Scalable Mobile Application for Performing Full Text Search(FTS) in SQLite Database

Submitted to Caterpillar on 09-12-2021

1. Statement of Work:

Problem Statement:

A scalable mobile application should be developed which is capable of searching through the HTML content that is stored in a mobile database such as SQLite in an offline mode. This application should work in various mobile environments such as Android, iOS and Windows.

Detailed Summary:

The objective of this project is to develop a scalable mobile application that has the ability to search across the HTML content which is stored in a mobile database such as SQLite. The mobile device user initially downloads all the relevant documents such as operation manuals and other pertinent documentations. It should not be stored as flat files in the mobile device.

When the user is in the field, he/she may not have the internet connection. Hence, there should not be a necessity for the mobile device to connect to any server for performing this search. The search should happen entirely in an offline mode. The response time for producing the results should not exceed 5 seconds even when the database size becomes 10 GB.

The result of a search query should be in a predetermined order and it should have 50 characters before and after the exact keyword(s). The search should not be performed on the HTML semantic tags.

A simplistic minimal UI needs to be developed, with search bar, order by and filter options, and the time taken for the search query and pagination to present the search results in multiple pages without overwhelming the user. Optionally, the size of the database that is being searched, can also be displayed. Optionally, an *order by* feature can be provided to the end-user. Filtering options should be provided for end-users to make the search more effective. Join queries should involve at least 5 different tables.

For queries that contain complex keywords, the document needs to be searched for an exact matching string. Optionally, the keywords can also be tokenized for queries that contain



complex keywords by using delimiters and can be subsequently searched on individual tokens. This tokenization should exclude the duplicate search results resultant from hits on searching for individual tokens while presenting to the user. If the retrieved set of results is more than 50 records, then pagination should be implemented to display the results incrementally.

As a proof of concept, this can initially be developed with biodata of students belonging to different departments instead of the actual Caterpillar operation manuals and documentations. The mobile application can be initially developed for the Android platform. It can later be extended to other platforms such as iOS and Windows.




Figure 1: System Framework
