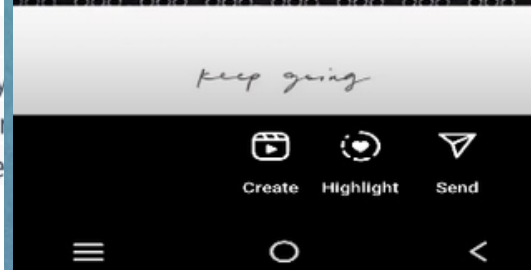
MY FAMILY ----

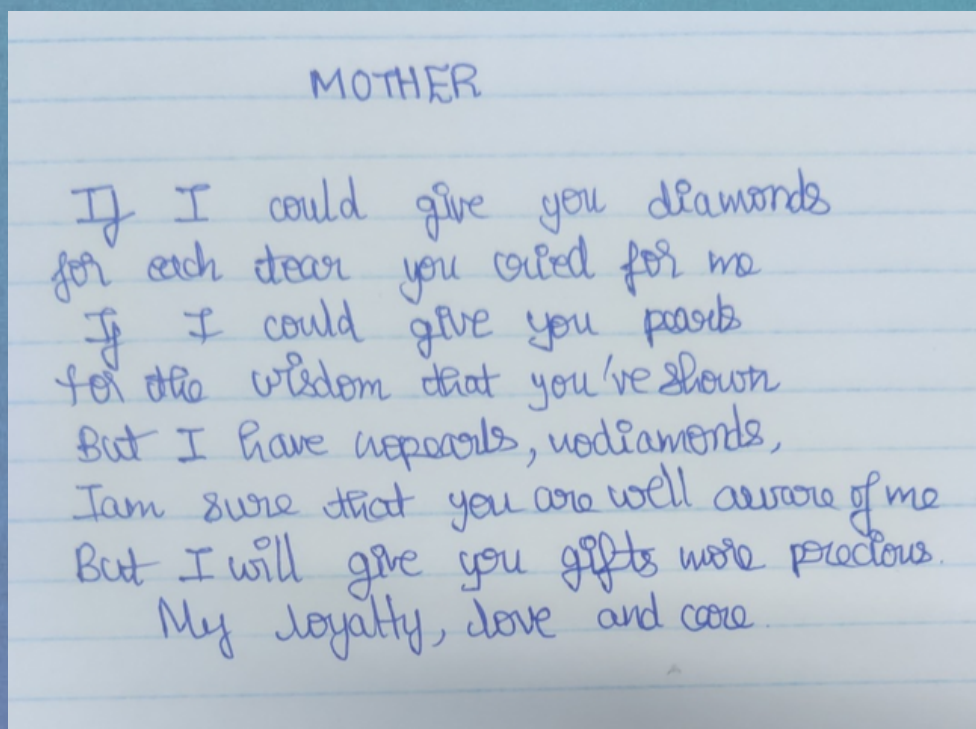

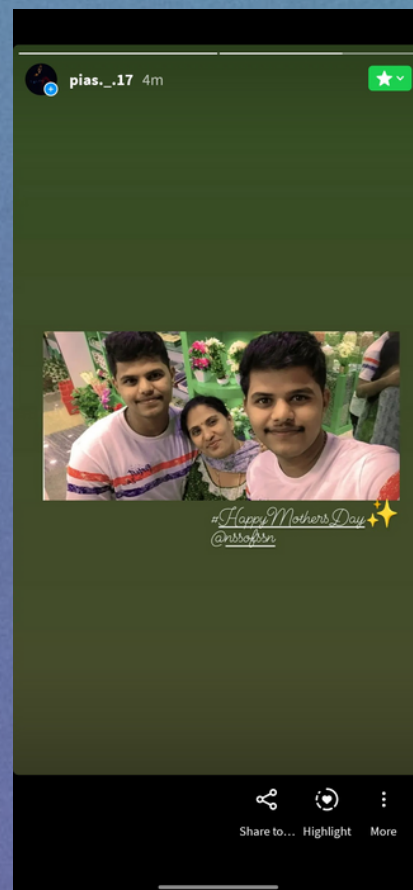
When times were tough,

The NSS Unit of SSN organized an online event named "COOL THE GLOBE" with the aim of raising awareness about sustainability among 1st and 2nd-year students. The event took place from May 24th to June 24th, spanning a total of 32 days. The event was hosted on the "COOL THE GLOBE" app, providing a platform for participants to engage in activities focused on reducing carbon emissions and promoting eco-friendly practices.

The primary objective of the "COOL THE GLOBE" event was to introduce the participating students to the concept of sustainability and encourage them to adopt environmentally conscious behaviors. Participants were engaged in activities that focused on reducing carbon emissions and contributing positively to the environment.

During the 32-day event, participants actively took part in a variety of sustainable practices to earn attendance hours. The activities included opting for two-wheelers over four-wheelers to reduce carbon emissions from commuting, turning off unnecessary electronic devices such as air conditioners, water heaters, fans, and lights to conserve energy, and avoiding the use of single-use plastics, thus contributing to a reduction in plastic waste.

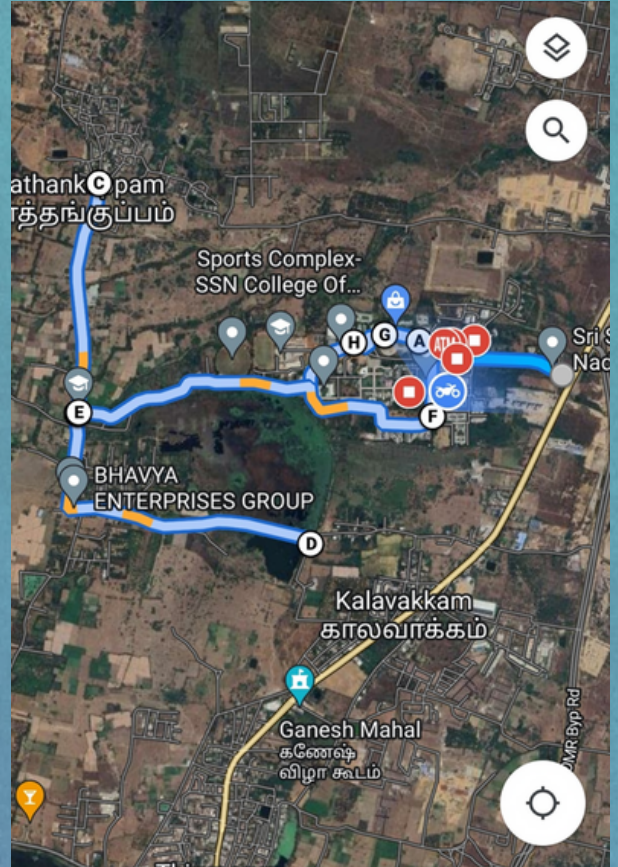
