

B. Terms of Members:

The term of the nominated members shall be two years.

C. Meetings:

The Principal shall convene a meeting of the Academic Council at least once a year.

D. Functions:

Without prejudice to the generality of functions mentioned, the Academic Council will have powers to:

- Scrutinise and approve the proposals with or without modification of the Boards of Studies with regard to courses of study, academic regulations, curricula, syllabi and modifications thereof, instructional and evaluation arrangements, methods, procedures relevant thereto etc., provided that where the Academic Council differs on any proposal, it will have the right to return the matter for reconsideration to the Board of Studies concerned or reject it, after giving reasons to do so.
- Make regulations regarding the admission of students to different programmes of study in the college.
- Make regulations for sports, extra-curricular activities, and proper maintenance and functioning of the playgrounds and hostels.
- Recommend to the Governing Body proposals for institution of new programmes of study.
- Recommend to the Governing Body institution of scholarships, studentships, fellowships, prizes and medals, and to frame regulations for the award of the same.
- Advise the Governing Body on suggestions(s) pertaining to academic affairs made by it.
- Perform such other functions as may be assigned by the Governing Body.

Service rules, procedures, recruitment, and promotional policies

The faculty when he/she is appointed, is given an appointment order. The order gives the compensation structure, to whom to report, his responsibilities, benefits, and incentives etc. at SSNCE. A compendium of rules, titled 'Service rules for teaching faculty of SSN Institutions' is available in the library for perusal of those who would like to refer to it. If there is any amendment or alterations, it is referred to the teachers in any one of the faculty meetings.

The faculty position is reviewed sometime during the second half of January, after compiling the requests of the HODs. After discussions, it is advertised, and faculties are recruited as indicated in Item 4 of 10.1.2 above.

For promotions the rules laid down by AICTE for Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) is adopted at the same time maintaining the cadre ratio as well as Student Faculty ratio.

Decentralization in Working and Grievance Redressal Mechanism

The working and administrative decisions are taken by following a hierarchy. The hierarchy maintained is President, Principal, HOD and Faculty in the same order.

The grievance redressal mechanism is explained below.

1. Grievance Redressal Committee for Faculty

This is an internal committee comprising of senior faculty to address the expressed grievances of the faculty. The committee normally meets once a year or when situations warrant as decided by the Principal.

The Grievance Redressal committee will comprise of heads of Departments, other than the department to which the aggrieved faculty belongs, with the senior most among them being the Chairman. The committee will meet and give its recommendations to the Principal for necessary action.

2. Grievance Redressal Committee for Students

This is an internal committee meant to address the grievances of the students, either through the suggestion box or through the class teacher or through their representative mentors or the HOD. It meets once a month or whenever a situation warranting the conduct of the meeting arises. The composition of the committee is given below:
