## Career Development Workshop by Alumni Association

### Career Development Programme from **Mechanical Department**

As part of the Monthly Alumni Activities, an **interaction session** for **November 2025** was organized by the **Mechanical Department**. **Mr. Eashwar D. J.** (**PG – Manufacturing 2023-2025 Batch**) interacted with the **Third Year and Final Year Mechanical Engineering students** on **November 30, 2025**. He is currently working at **Gurit, Chennai**.

The **Gurit Chennai site** is a large manufacturing facility producing **PET structural foam and related core kitting services**, and more recently, **tooling and manufacturing solutions** as well as **pultruded structural profiles** to serve the **global wind industry**. Since its inauguration last June, the site has achieved several milestones, including the dispatch of **thousands of PET structural core materials and 200 kits**.

The interaction session was conducted **online**, during which **Mr. Eashwar** shared his work experience and provided valuable advice on **placement preparation**, including several practical tips to help students succeed in their career planning.

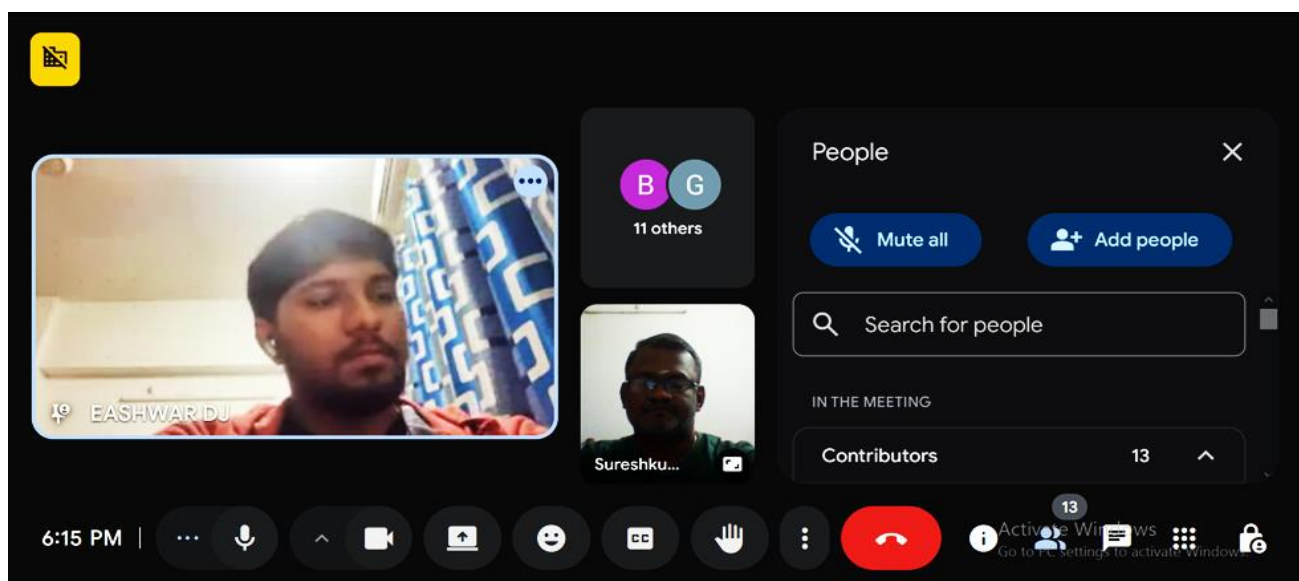

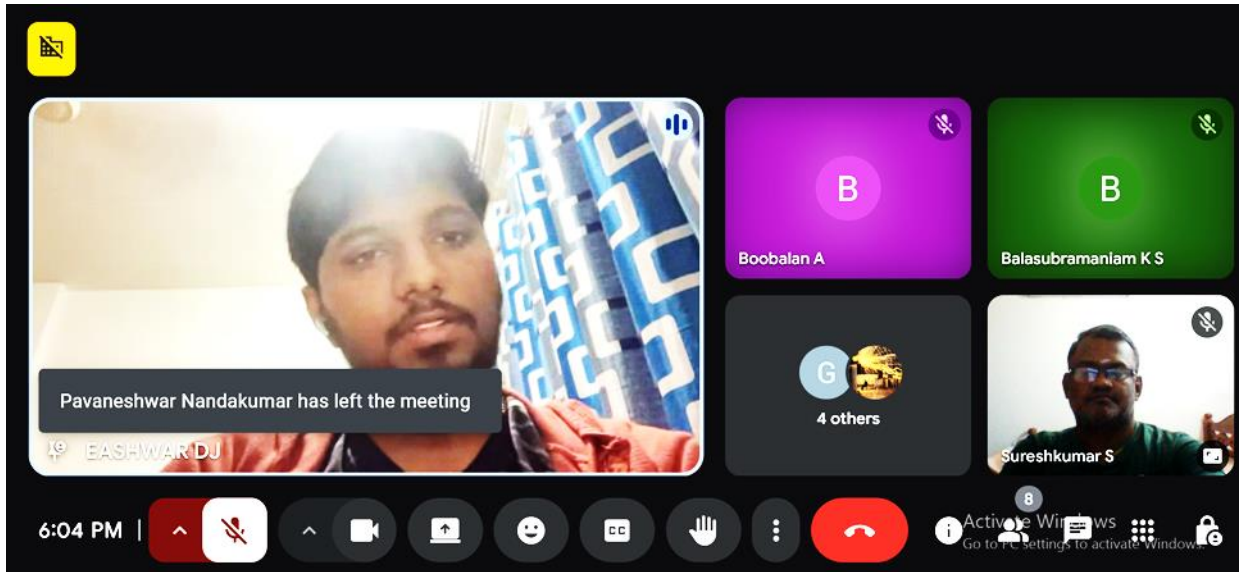

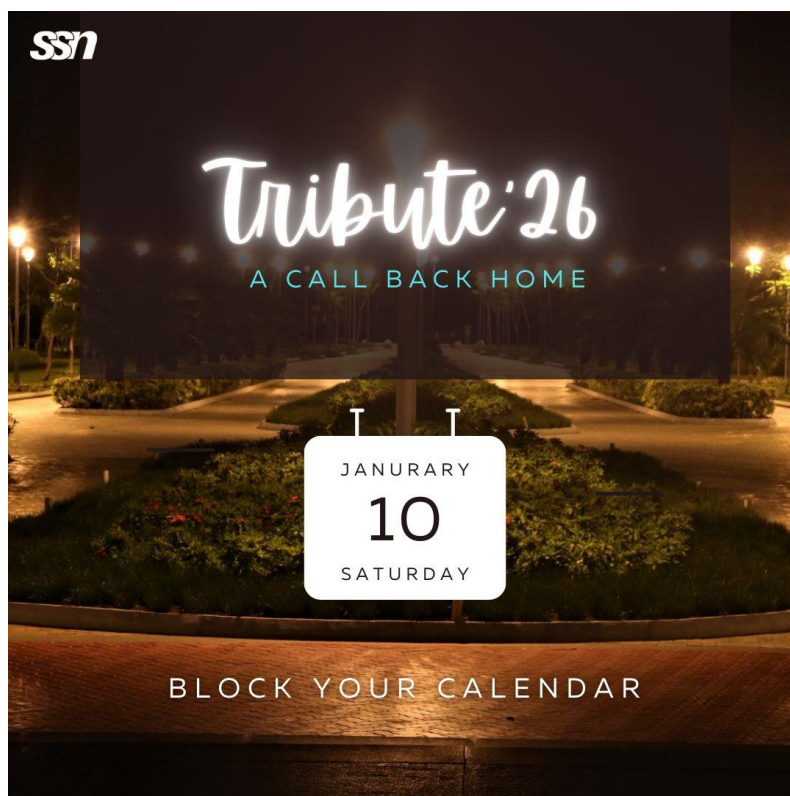

The scholarship campaign will remain open throughout the year, enabling alumni to continue contributing towards student support initiatives.

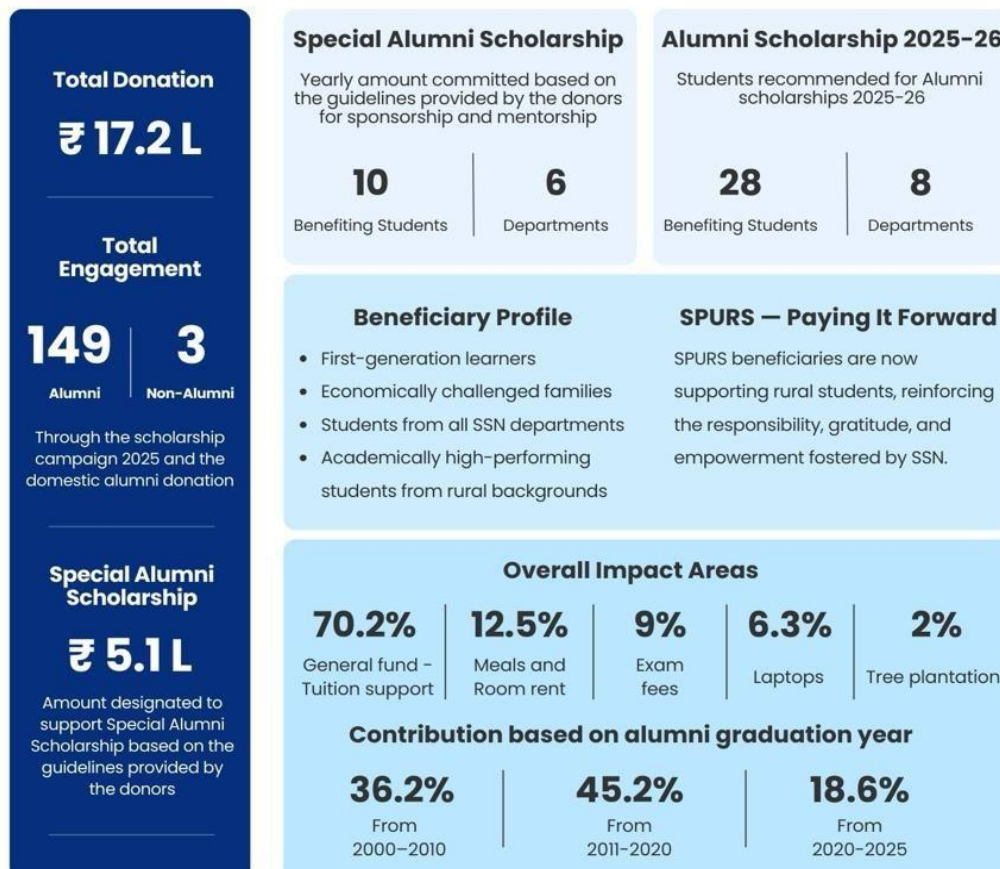
