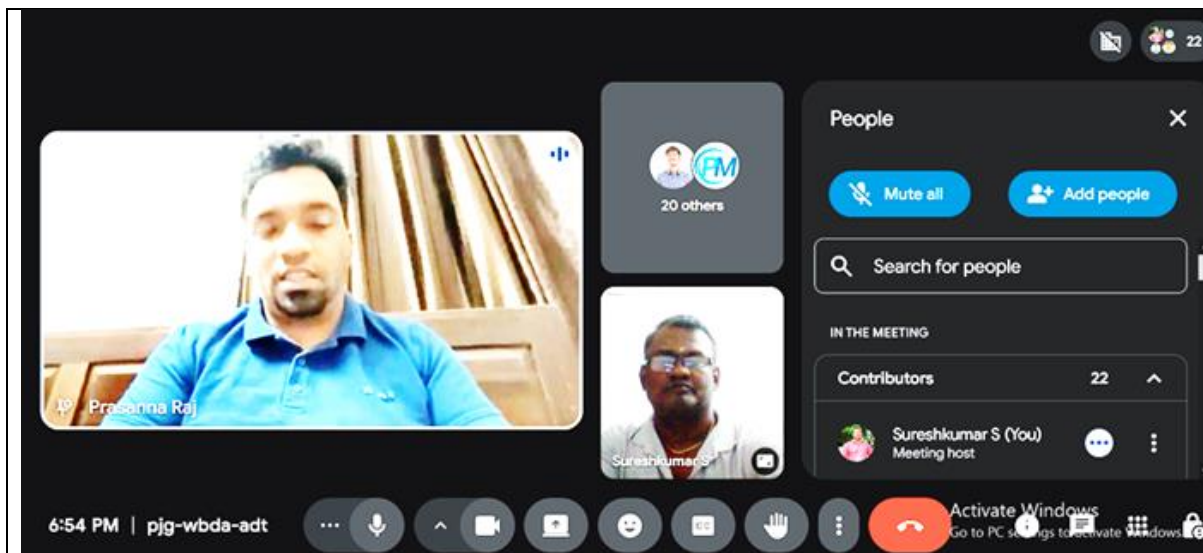


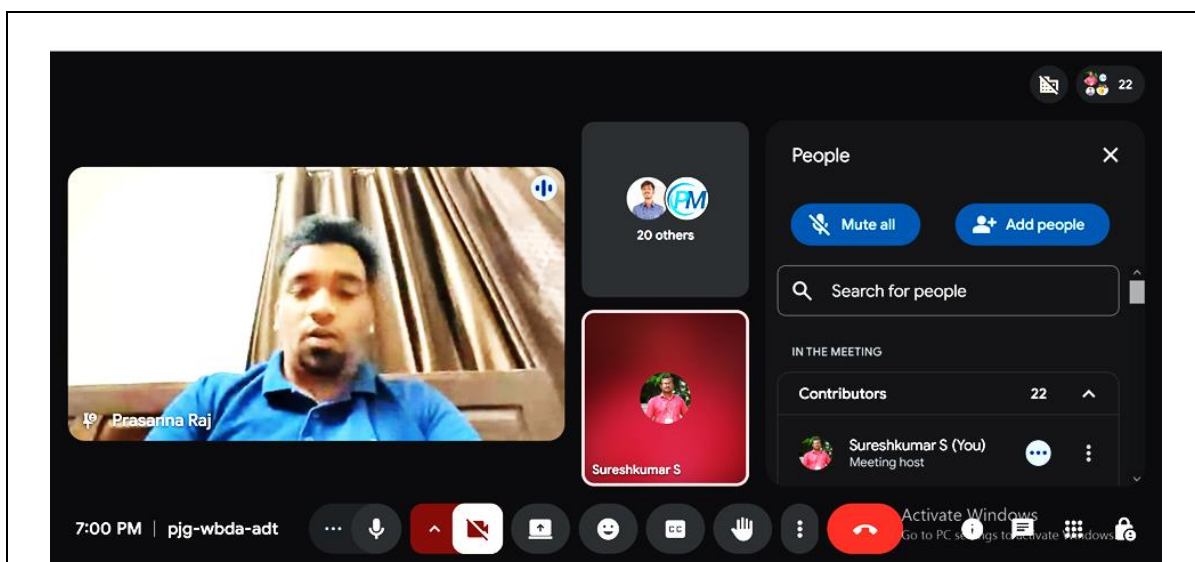

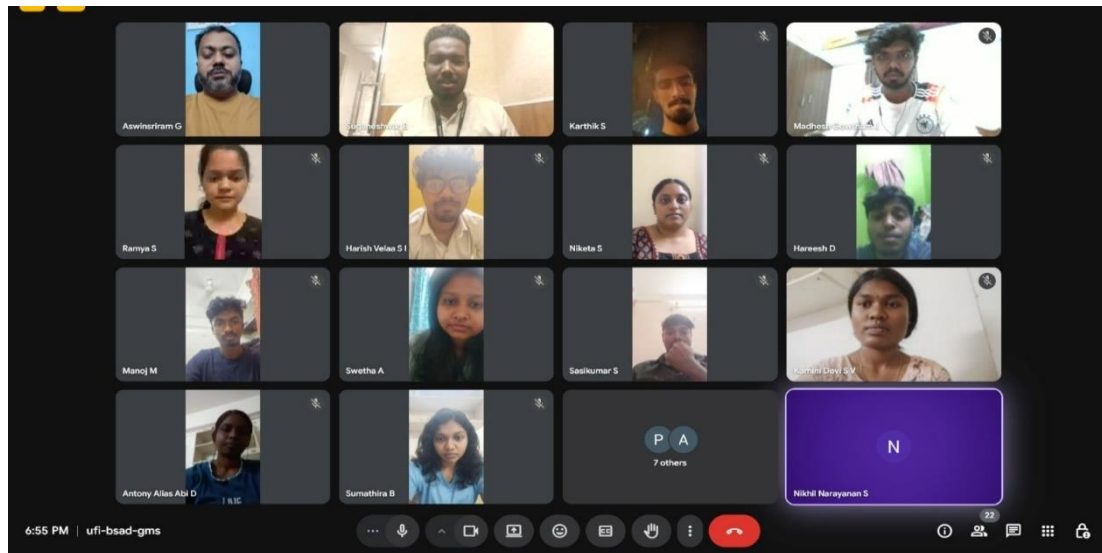

**Event 3: CSE Alumna Industry Talk on Cloud Technologies in the AI Era – CSE Department**

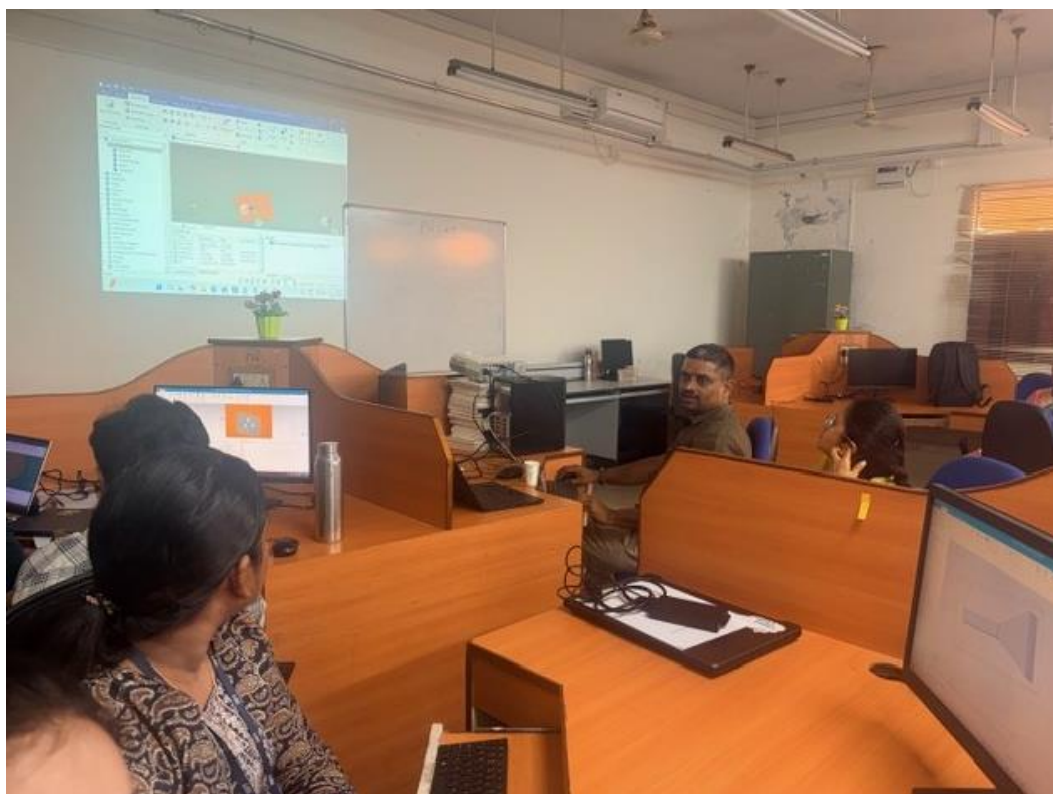

#### Event 5: Alumna Interaction on Human–Machine Interfaces and Neurorehabilitation – BME Department

The **IEEE Photonics Society** and the **IEEE Signal Processing Society (SPS) Student Chapter**, in association with the **Department of Biomedical Engineering (BME)**, organized an invited talk titled “*Mapping Neuromuscular Pathways Using Non-invasive Multimodal Techniques*” on January 7, 2026.

The session was delivered by **Ms. Supraja Vaidhyanathan** (B.E. BME Batch of 2024), currently a **Ph.D. scholar** at the **REIGN Lab, University of Houston**, specializing in **Human–Machine Interfaces**. She presented recent advancements in **non-invasive multimodal sensing** and stimulation techniques for investigating neuromuscular pathways, highlighting their applications in **neurorehabilitation and movement analysis**.

Students were introduced to advanced tools and methodologies, including **EEG, EMG, brain stimulation techniques**, motion capture systems, and **rehabilitation robotics**. The talk also emphasized the **expanding role of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning** in neural signal

**interpretation.** The interactive session generated significant interest among students in the fields of neurotechnology and biomedical research.

## Event 6: Alumni Talk Series | Navigating industry trends and Expectations – SSN School of Management

The first Alumni Talk series organised on **January 2, 2026**, by alumni committee of **MBA 2025-27 Batch (ALUMNI COMMITTEE (ALCOM))** was kickstarted by an engaging session led by **Mr. Ravi Shankar (MBA Batch 2007-2009)**, **Director- Cloud infrastructure Security – Nordics, Technology Business Leader – Nordics and Executive Board Member, SSN Alumni Association**. The session marked the beginning of a new initiative to bridge academic learning with real world corporate expectations, especially in an AI driven professional environment.

The discussion centred on how artificial intelligence is reshaping industries and job roles, encouraging students to approach the evolving job market with clarity rather than anxiety. While AI is impacting entry level and routine roles, the speaker highlighted that **humancentric skills emotional intelligence, leadership, communication, and decision making remain critical**, particularly in HR, sales, and managerial functions.

A key takeaway was the importance of **choosing specialisations aligned with individual strengths**, while remaining adaptable and committed to continuous upskilling. The session also offered practical insights into AI driven recruitment, résumé shortlisting, responsible use of AI tools, managing job market competition, and building differentiated skill sets for long term career growth.

What made the session impactful was its highly interactive format, with students actively engaging on **career paths, specialisation choices, and post MBA expectations**. Addressed through real world examples and actionable advice, the session laid a **strong foundation for continued alumni-student engagement**, leaving students with **greater clarity, confidence, and preparedness** for an evolving corporate landscape.

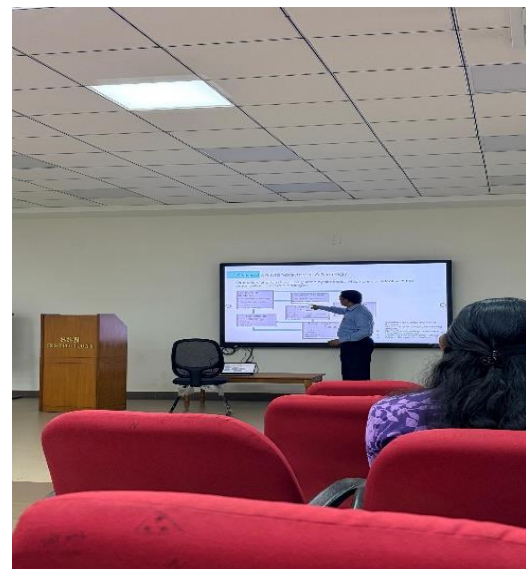
## Event 7: Alumni in Academics | Operations Management – SSN School of Management

As part of alumni involvement in academic delivery, **Mr. Karthik Vaithiyathan** (MBA Batch 2008–2010), Chief Operating Officer & Head – Business Development at IP Rings, is handling the Operations Management course for the second semester MBA students. He engages with students to share practical insights on **operations management** and **business efficiency**, drawing directly from real-world experience.

The sessions highlight how operational excellence is built through the careful balancing of productivity, quality, cost, delivery, safety, and employee morale, emphasizing that consistency and timely execution are critical to sustained business performance. Students are gaining clarity on how **operational decisions**, often made behind the scenes, significantly influence organizational outcomes.

Focusing on operations strategy, the discussion explores efficient resource utilization, cost control, and quick decision-making as levers for achieving short-term objectives without compromising long-term stability. Competitive priorities such as speed, quality, flexibility, and cost were explained through relatable examples, making complex concepts accessible and relevant.

The sessions also connect operations with market positioning, introducing approaches such as **cost leadership, product differentiation, and lean practices** like Just-In-Time (JIT). By linking theory with practice, the interaction reinforces how classroom concepts translate into effective operational strategy, underscoring the valuable role alumni play in strengthening academic learning.

## Event 8: Alumni in Academics | Sustainability and ESG – SSN School of Management

**Ms. Bhavani Sruthi**, (MBA Batch 2021–2023), Assistant Global Sustainability Manager, **Blackstone Shipping**, handles the course on Sustainability and ESG for the second semester MBA students. The sessions offer students a structured understanding of how organisations integrate responsibility with long term value creation. Through discussions, presentations, and group activities, the sessions explore sustainability as the efficient and responsible use of resources with a clear future orientation.

Students examine how sustainability extends beyond intent into measurable action, guided by the three core dimensions—**environmental, economic, and social**. Case examples of multinational companies such as Coca Cola and Ashok Leyland highlighted how organisations assess their societal impact alongside business performance, while brand narratives like Unilever’s sustainability communication illustrated the strong link between **CSR, ESG, and brand positioning**.

The sessions also introduced key frameworks such as the **Triple Bottom Line, ESG reporting**, and sustainability ratings, helping students understand how corporate responsibility is evaluated, reported, and perceived by stakeholders. By connecting sustainability metrics with strategy and branding, the class reinforced that responsible business practices are no longer optional, but integral to long term competitiveness and credibility.

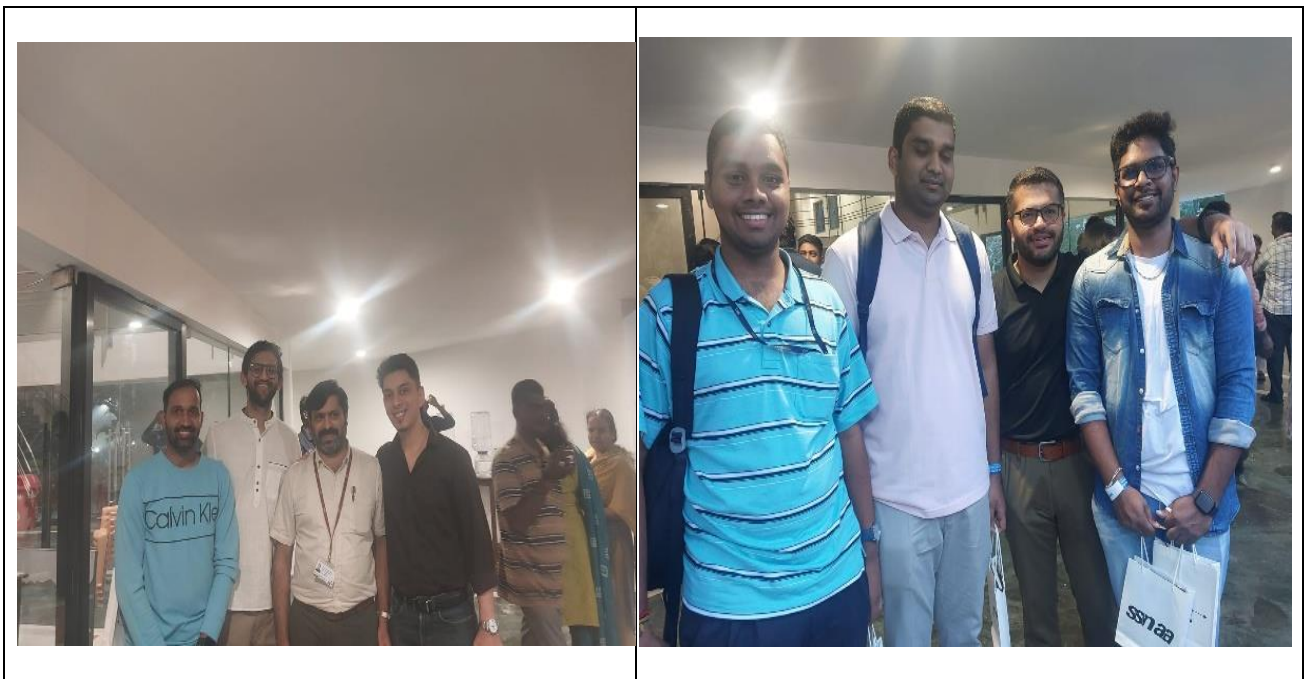

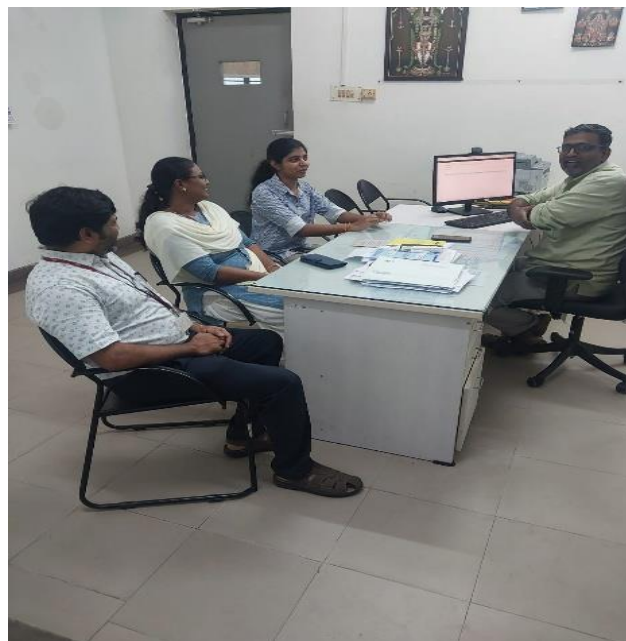

## Alumni Recognition

### Recognition Rooted in Responsibility and Reflection

At the **Tribute 2026** Annual alumni meet, **Mr. Ravi Shankar (MBA Batch 2007–2009), Technology Business Leader – Nordics and Executive Board Member, SSN Alumni Association**, was conferred with the **HIGHEST ALUMNI AWARD** given by SSN institutions/ Shiv Nadar University, Chennai – **Distinguished Alumni Award 2025**, recognising a professional and social journey marked by consistency, responsibility, and sustained engagement with the institution. He is the **First MBA alumni** being honoured with this award.

In his acceptance address, Ravi Shankar reflected on the formative role the campus played in shaping his professional outlook. He spoke about learning as a continuous process, one that extends beyond classrooms and demands curiosity, discipline, and adaptability. A central theme of his message was **ownership**: taking responsibility for decisions, outcomes, and values, particularly in moments of uncertainty.

He emphasised that meaningful careers are built through small, deliberate choices made consistently over time, rather than isolated achievements. Encouraging students to focus on strong fundamentals, he highlighted the importance of staying grounded, being open to feedback, and viewing setbacks as opportunities for growth.

The address also underscored the responsibility that comes with professional progress. Success, he noted, gains significance when it enables individuals to **GIVE BACK** by sharing experience, guiding others, and contributing to the wider community.

The **Distinguished Alumni Award 2025** thus recognises not only professional accomplishment, but a mindset aligned with the institution's values clarity of thought, accountability in action, and commitment to collective growth. 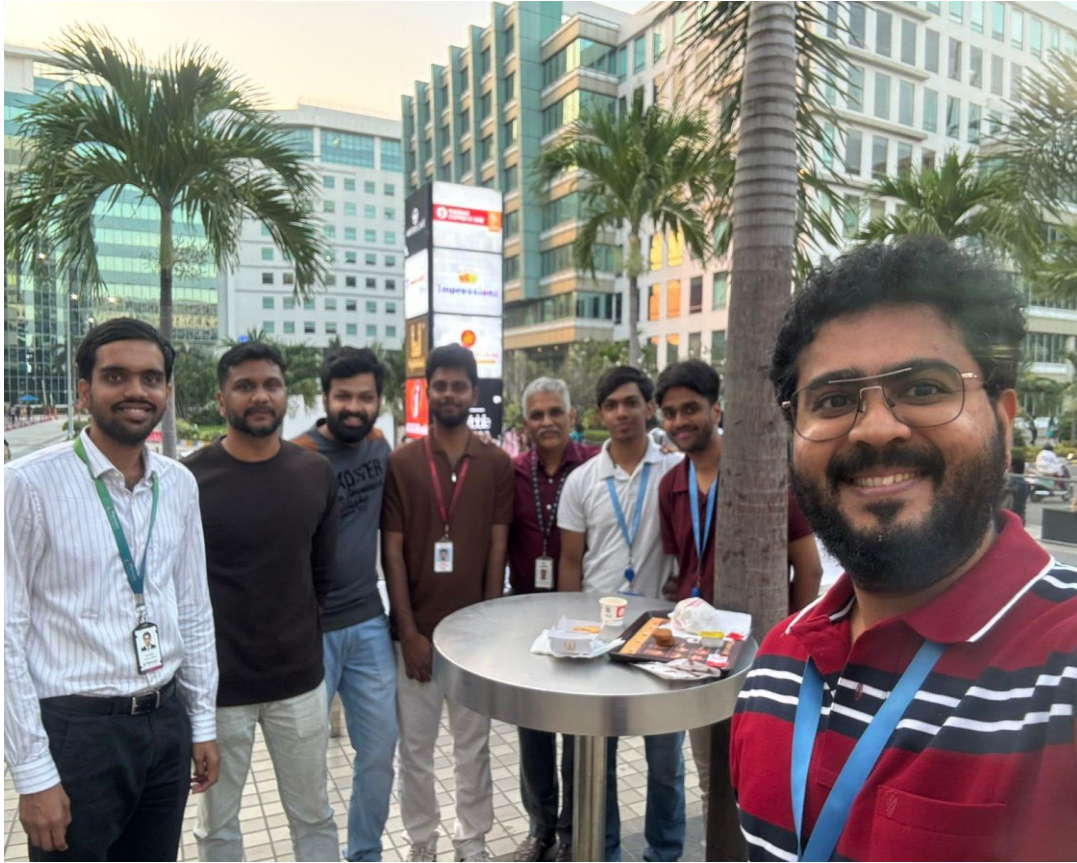
#### **SSN Alumni Meet at DLF**
