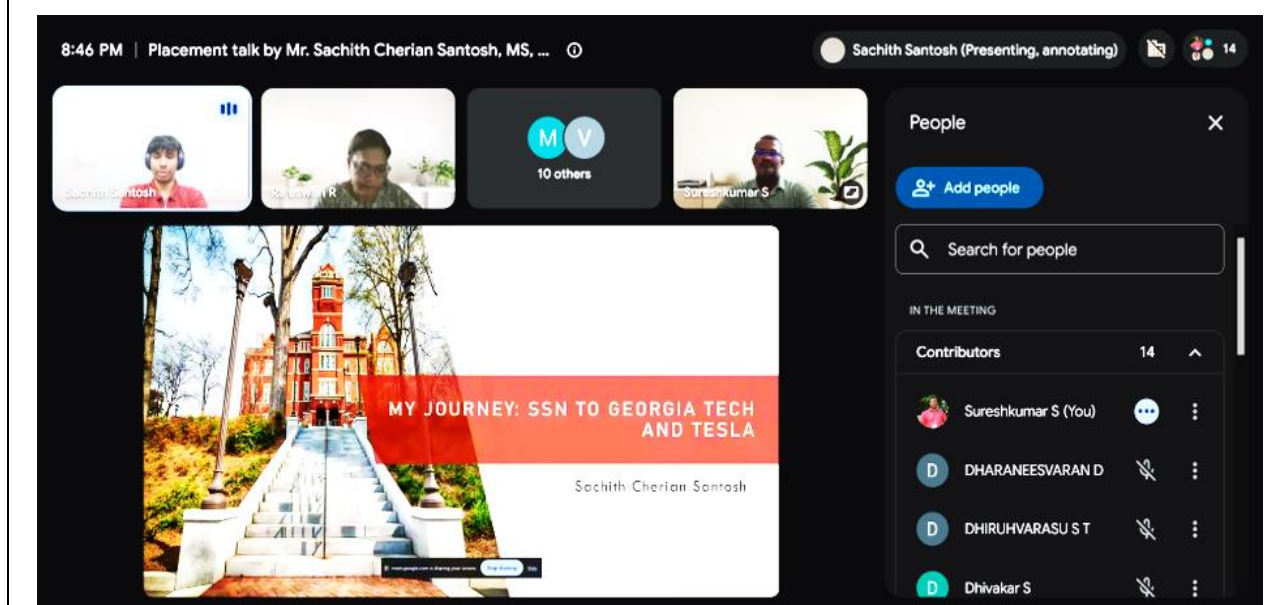

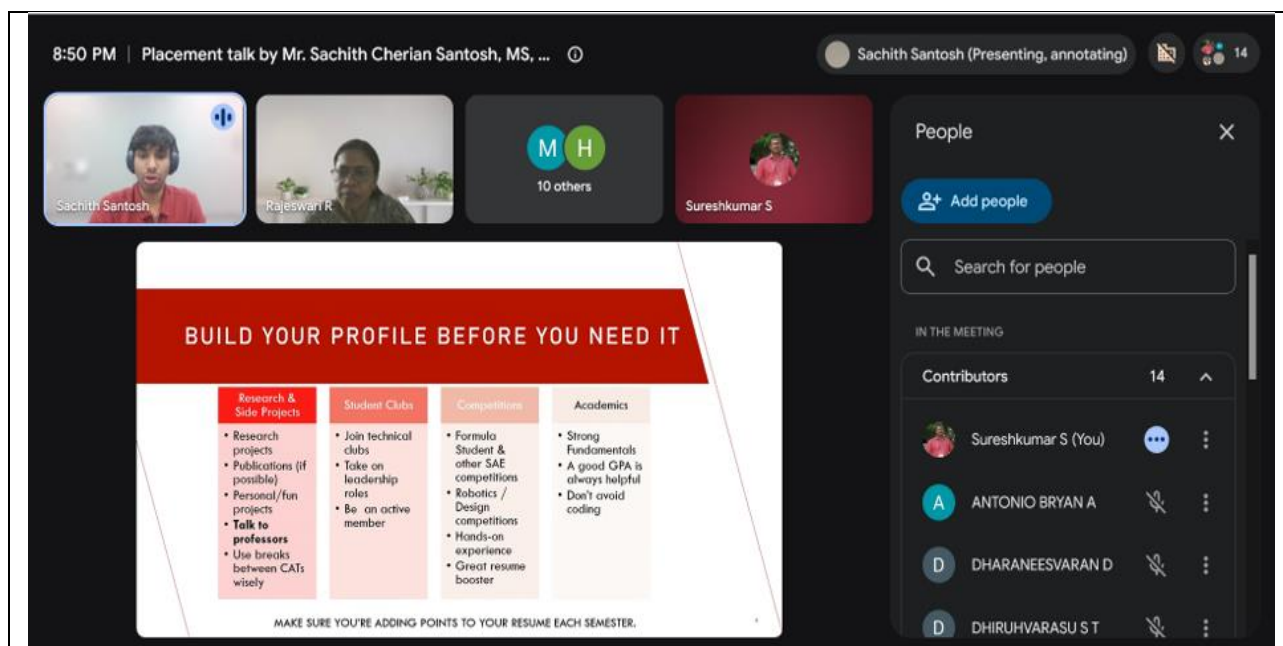

Career Development Programme from Civil Department

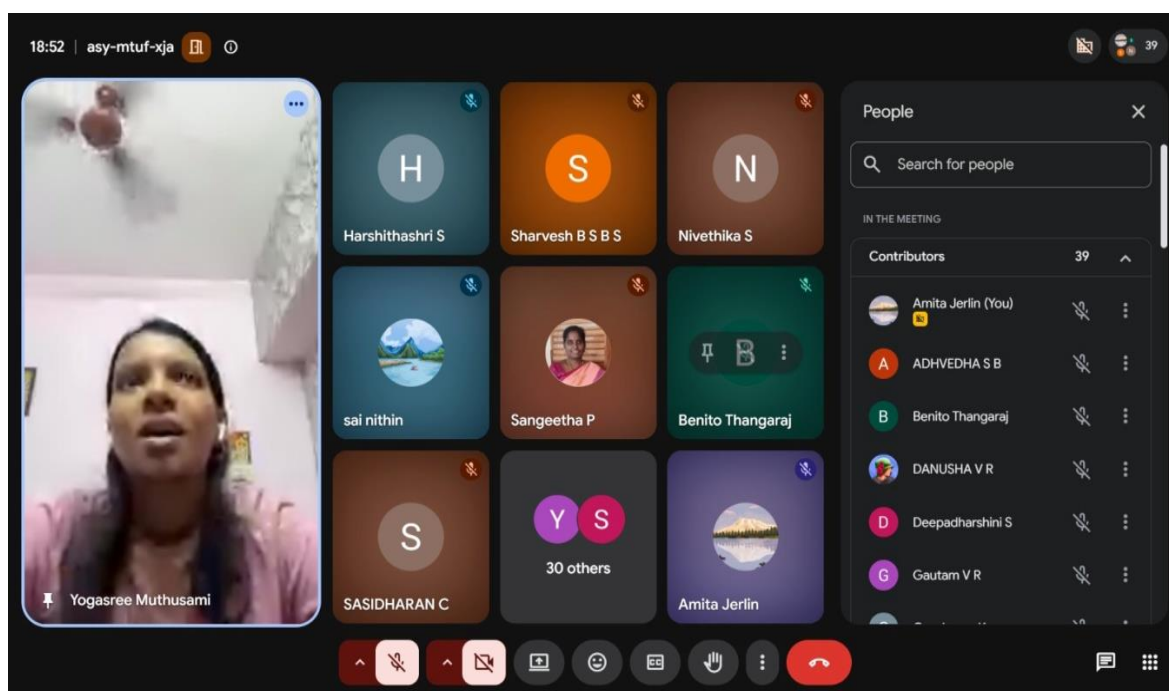
Programme 1:

Further, she provided valuable insights into her decision to pursue higher studies at **TU Delft**, the application process, and her preparations for adapting to academic life abroad.

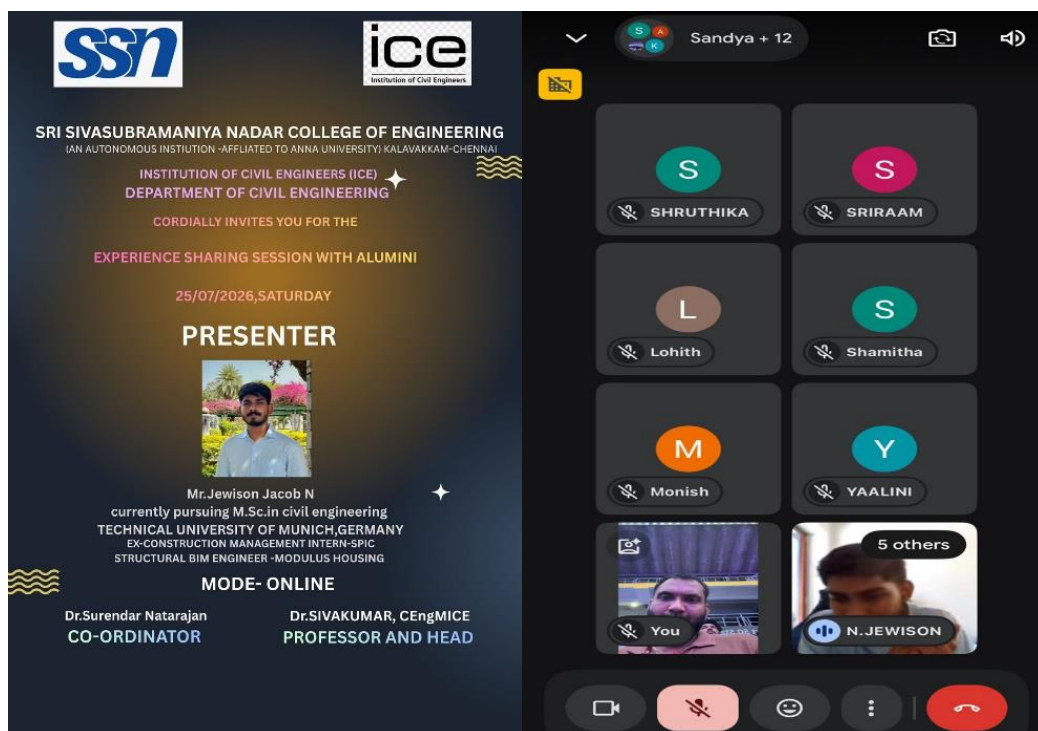

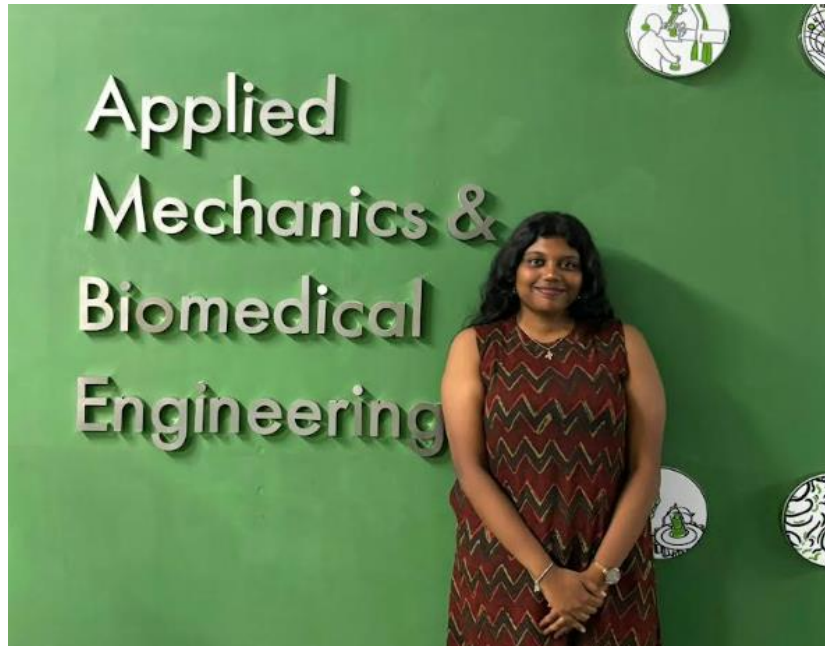

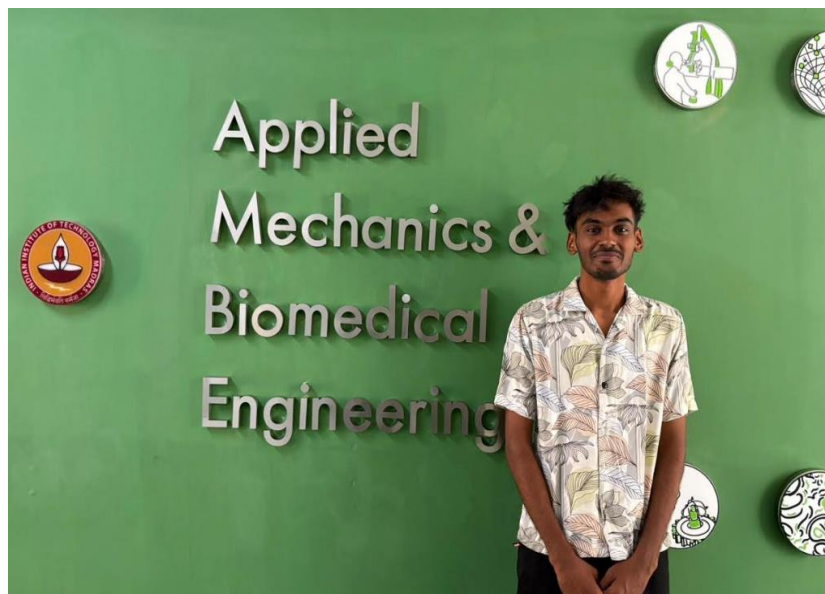
